Stephen Herring's 2:49:32 at Crowley, LA qualified him as did Jerry Smith's 2:59:29 in the same race. John Pendergrass just missed the mark at Crowley with a 2:50:42. David Cundiff qualified at Crowley and again at the Mississippi Marathon in 2:57:49. Paula Porter recorded a near miss at Honolulu finishing less than 5 minutes off the qualifying time. The Hattiesburg Track Club will be represented at Boston by David Cundiff (3rd Boston) and Stephen Herring (1st Boston). 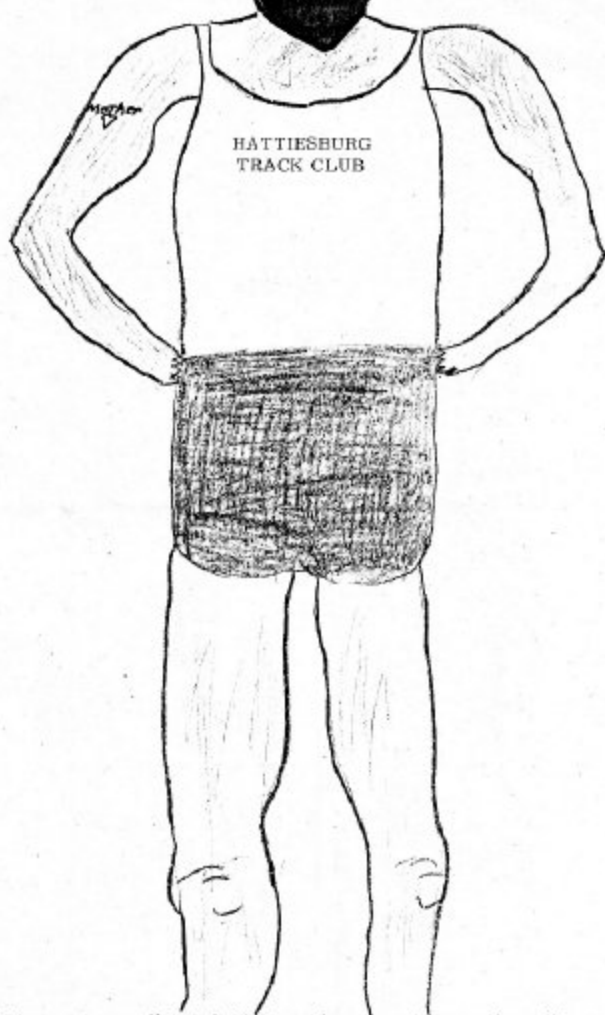
